- Design Structures may be realistic or imaginary, able to withstand hours of display. All visible
 pieces must be edible. (eg. savory or sweet items may be used; candies, pretzels, vegetables,
 dried fruit etc.) The interior structure may be made of non-edible material as long as it isn't
 visible.. (Eg. milk or juice cartons etc.)

 - Entries for the following category; 5. Village Display (collaborative)- 5-12 small houses must be on a solid base no larger than 18 x 24 inches and no taller than 18 inches.
