Guidelines

- Design Structures may be realistic or imaginary, able to withstand hours of display. All visible pieces must be edible. (eg. savory or sweet items may be used; candies, pretzels, vegetables, dried fruit etc.) The interior structure may be made of non-edible material as long as it isn't visible.. (Eg. milk or juice cartons etc.)

 - Children 3rd-5th
 - Children 6th-8th
 - Adult 9th & Up
- 3. Design & Size Parameters -
 - In each category the Gingerbread Committee will accept; **individual entries**, **group entries and a village display** ie. more than one structure built on a single base.
 - Your gingerbread house or houses must be on a solid base no larger than 18 x 24 inches and no taller than 18 inches.

(Suggested base materials; cookie sheet, sturdy cardboard, canvas panel or plywood)
